
JCORE petitions on social justice

A Jewish human rights group has called on British Jews to "renew our commitment to social justice" by demanding the government take several simple steps to help refugees work, settle and reunite with families.

The Jewish Council for Racial Equality (JCORE) used its Rosh Hashanah appeal to

ask supporters to sign a petition, found on its website, calling on the government to allow asylum seekers to work while their applications are processed, and to fund a resettlement programme for those allowed to stay. It said the appeal was made "at a time when our own politics and society are tainted by prejudice".
